

What is the Super Y League?

The Super Y League is a national system designed for talented youth players destined for college, professional or international careers. For more information on Super Y League visit www.superyleague.com

Which clubs compete in Super Y League?

Over 100 clubs throughout North America compete annually for a National Championship. Fever Y League teams participate in the Midwest Division. This year, the Fever will compete against Indiana Invaders, Kalamazoo Kingdom, West Michigan Fire, Toronto Lynx, Cleveland Internationals, Mequon United, Chicago Magic, Alliance FC, Chicago Fire, Kings Soccer Academy, TKO and London Gryphon's.

When does the Super Y League season run?

The season consists of approximately 8 -14 games depending on the age division. The games are played during the summer months. For 2009 all Fever games will be played in July. The National finals are held every November in Florida.

What are the age brackets for the Super Y League?

The Super Y League uses the same USYSA age brackets (August 1 – July 31). The age bracket you participate in now is the age bracket in which you would play. Competition for Super Y League is only between the ages U13 to U17. Fever will field ten teams in 2009 with U13-U17 girls and U13-U17 boys. The U16 girls may have a different schedule.

Where will the team's practice and play home games?

Practices will take place in Fort Wayne at either Hefner Fields or the Dome. All home games will play at Hefner Fields.

How many players will be selected for each Super Y League team?

Between 18-26 players will be selected for each team. Up to a maximum of 18 players are selected for each game day roster. This quantity of players is selected in order to fill the 18 player game day roster.

What uniforms will the Super Y League teams use?

The Super Y League teams will wear the Fever regular season Diadora uniforms. New or non-Fever players will have to purchase a uniform package, this will include one black jersey, one white jersey, one pair of black shorts, and one pair of socks. The cost is \$75 per uniform kit.

How will transportation to away games be coordinated?

This will be coordinated on a team by team basis.

How will lodging for over-night trips be coordinated?

Players will be responsible for their own hotel and cost of meals for all over-night stays.

For the AC Milan Continental Cup in Cleveland, players will be responsible for their hotel and food costs, but will stay in designated hotels as teams. The club has block booked more than 100 rooms for this event.

How much is the Super Y League fee?

The fee is \$495, plus uniform (\$75) for new or non-Fever players.

What do my fees cover?

Your fees cover the coach's salary, travel and food costs, Super Y League registration fees, player registration fees, referee fees, field rental fees, and administration costs. This year it also includes entry fee's into the AC Milan Continental Cup.

You will have one mandatory training session every week, with an optional session also available. A mini-camp will take place on June 20 and 21 this will also double as a tryout for certain players who have not been offered a place on a team.

How do I register?

Download documents and send to Fever office.

When will selections be posted? Coaches will contact players and will begin filling the roster in March, but will not complete the team until after the mini-camp (June 20/21). Once accepted to a team, you will be asked to accept your position online and provide a \$150 non-refundable deposit on or before April 15th, plus uniform order for new players of \$75.

The remaining \$345 may be split and a credit card form filled in where payments will be due May 15th (\$150), and a final payment of \$195 will be due by June 15, 2009.

*If you wish to pay all of your fees (\$495) prior to April 15, a \$50 discount is available.
